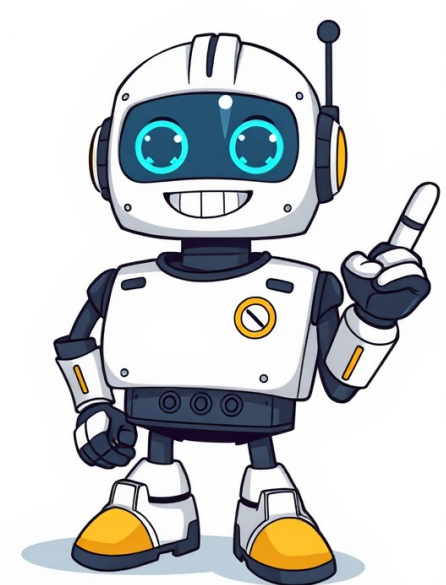

The B95 introduced a new forward-facing fifth seat, while the B95A featured fuel injection and a longer cabin with available sixth seats. This model falls under the category of light, light twins, which also includes the Piper Twin Comanche and Apache. These planes are favored by pilots due to their low fuel consumption and reliable engines. Despite newer models like the Piper Seminole and Beechcraft Duchess entering the market in the late 1970s, Travel Airs have maintained a strong performance level. Their popularity lies in their affordability and ease of maintenance, making them suitable for both training and personal use. Travel Airs are well-suited for families with smaller children, as they can accommodate two or three preteens. Although most variants lack the capacity to carry four adults, they provide an excellent handling experience reminiscent of the Bonanza/Baron family. With crisp roll rates, rapid speed increases, and good climb rates, the Travel Air offers a sporty feel. However, on one engine, the aircraft's performance is less impressive, with a single-engine climb rate of 205 feet per minute. Visibility through the cockpit is excellent, particularly in later models with larger aft windows, which creates an open and airy atmosphere. The cabin may be narrow, but it provides generous leg- and headroom. Pilots of Travel Airs are not immune to certain challenges, such as inadvertent gear retractions on the ground due to a design quirk. This issue is more common among light-twin manufacturers than heavier variants. Additionally, the throttles are located centrally, which can cause confusion for pilots accustomed to other configurations. =====the travel air's fuel management system has been known to cause problems for pilots, there are four bladder-type fuel cells, but only two gauges in the cockpit to monitor them, this can lead to confusion and accidents, especially during takeoff, landing, and maneuvering flight, the fuel system requires regular maintenance, but it's not foolproof, despite its complexity, many travel air owners have found that the airplane is a good value for its price. however, prospective buyers need to be aware of the potential costs of ownership, including expensive repairs and replacement parts. the travel air's magnesium control surfaces can corrode over time, requiring costly replacements. a thorough inspection by an expert can help identify any issues before purchase, the condition of remaining fleet can vary greatly, with some airplanes having been used as trainers while others have been well-maintained by individual owners. one example of a well-restored travel air is n69va, a 1968 e95 that has been extensively modified and upgraded with modern avionics and equipment. its owner, john beaulieu, uses the airplane for personal and business use, flying it to meetings and sales calls throughout virginia and beyond. despite its age, the travel air remains a popular choice for first-time twin owners and flight schools due to its speed, economy, and redundancy. however, buyers need to be aware of potential expenses such as propeller replacement and ongoing maintenance costs.The Beech Travel Air E95, a regional airline aircraft with a rich history, boasts an impressive array of specifications that cater to its operational needs. Landing distances exceed 1,590 feet over 50-foot obstacles, while the ground roll distance measures 980 feet. Control and Maneuvering The aircraft features limiting and recommended airspeeds, including V R for rotation at 74 knots and V MC for minimum control in critical engine inoperative conditions.
